Dissolve an Activity

We often choose the menu option – **Edit, Delete** to delete an activity and its ties to other activities as well. However, by choosing the menu option - **Edit, Dissolve Activity**, you can easily delete the activity from a chain of the activities and still keep the logics.

For example: As shown below, when you choose the menu option - **Edit, Delete** to delete the Activity B, the ties between Activity A and C are also lost.

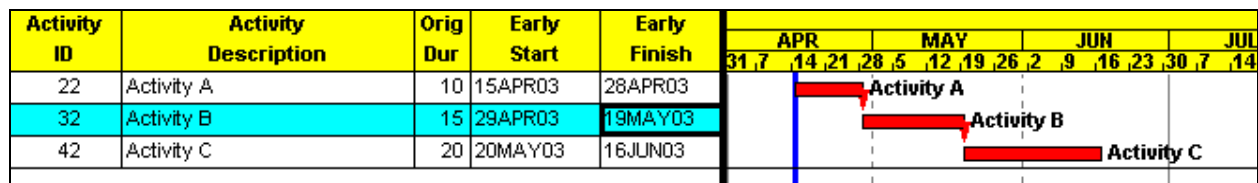

However, if you choose the menu option - **Edit, Dissolve Activity** to delete the Activity B, the ties between Activity A and C are automatically reconnected and the network logics are still maintained. After executing the menu option, a message will be prompted to confirm those ties to be reconnected. You can only dissolve one activity at a time.

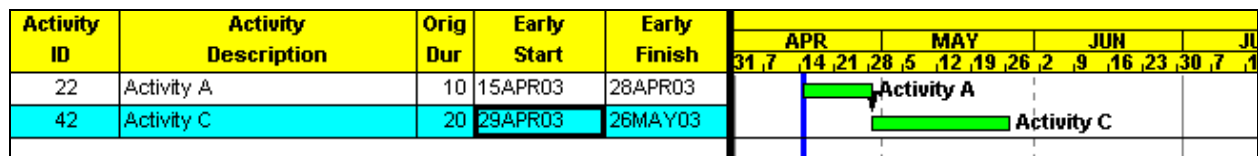


Figure 2 - After Dissolving
